As well as finding comedic success onstage (**Leicester Square New Comedian** 2015 finalist, **Laughing Horse New Act of the Year** 2014 runner up, **Fosters Golden Jester** 2013 winner), Falafel has also enjoyed online and TV fame on **Daniel Tosh's Comedy Central show Tosh.0** with his short viral videos.

Olaf's highly successful absurdist movies include a croissant-coiffured [talking Donald Trump puppet](#) (retweeted over 19,000 times, with 23 million views in total at the time of writing), slices of [truth telling cheese](#) being thrown onto newspapers and the [Bee Gees hiding in beards](#).

Olaf **enjoys an average of over 500 retweets a day** for his comedic output and had over 75 million views on the former social media platform Vine.

Falafel has also recently hit the headlines by securing publishing's fastest ever picture book deal for his semi-autobiographical masterpiece **Old MacDonald Heard A Fart**.
