Comedian, author and anaesthetist, **Ed Patrick** (*Have I Got News For You*, *Sky’s Friday Night with Niall Paterson*), re-injects the UK with a tour extension of his gut-punch hilarious show about becoming a junior doctor, the NHS, the pitfalls of modern medicine and the power of questioning it.

Laughing gas has been banned (but not in the NHS) and Ed Patrick might be forgiven for feeling numb, what with chronic understaffing and many leaving the NHS. In his role as an anaesthetist, Ed can be found almost anywhere in a hospital, from A&E dealing with emergencies to staffing intensive care units and giving epidurals to assist the joyous moments of childbirth. There’s more to his job than being a drug sommelier with a bit of magic thrown in, so join Ed on his travels and find out why the rectum is like the TARDIS and how, sometimes, having absolutely no medical knowledge can lead to better medical care.

Ed Patrick is a comedian, author and NHS anaesthetist who has performed across the UK, including at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival. Ed hosts the ***Comedians’ Surgery*** podcast where he speaks to fellow comedians about their health stories and experiences - previous guests have included **Phil Wang, Joe Lycett, Ahir Shah** and **Rose Matafeo**. Ed also created and presented ***Infectious Personalities*** with Hat Trick Productions, broadcast on **BBC Radio 2** with guests **Charlie Brooker** and **Sindhu Vee**. Other writing and performing credits include **BBC Radio 4** shows such as ***Now Wash Your Hands*** and ***Newsjack*** and Ed has appeared on Channel 4’s ***Jokes Only An NHS Worker Can Tell*** and on BBC Scotland.

Ed made his debut on ***Have I Got News For You*** in April 2024 and is a regular on Sky’s ***Friday Night with Niall Paterson***.

Ed’s book, ***Catch Your Breath***, was published in 2021 by Brazen (part of Octopus Publishing Group). He has also written for The Guardian about the intersection between medicine and comedy.
